How will I be billed?	<p>Charges for COLLECTIVE ENERGY Renewable Energy Certificates will appear as a separate line item on your regular bill from PG&E (for the PG&E utility region), or on a separate bill from Collective (for the Sempra Energy utility regions). Collective Energy RECs from Collective is a Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) product. The price of RECs is in addition to charges for your electricity. You will be charged separately for your electricity charges from your utility.</p>
How will my bill be calculated?	<p>CALLECTIVE Energy Renewable Energy Certificates are sold to commercial and residential customers based on an enrollment level selected for the initial 12 month period. The minimum purchase amount will be 500 kWh per Month. Each kilowatt hour of COLLECTIVE ENERGY Renewable Energy Certificates adds \$.015 (plus tax) to a customer's monthly energy bill, for the first 12 month term. This price may change at the contract renewal date, based on market conditions.</p> <p><i>Example: 1000 kWhs of Renewable Energy Certificates would cost \$15.00 (plus tax) per month in addition to the normal monthly bill— 1000 kWhs * (times) \$.015 per kWh = (equals) \$15.00 (plus tax).</i></p> <p>A billing service fee may apply (depending on the billing fees charged by the applicable utility for consolidated utility billing.). 	<p>late charge of 3% for bills that are unpaid for more than 24 days may be applied.</p> <p>This purchase is in addition to charges by your electric utility. You will continue to receive a separate electricity bill from your utility. COLLECTIVE ENERGY Renewable Energy Certificates is composed of Renewable Energy Certificates.</p>
What is my enrollment level?	<p>Charges for COLLECTIVE ENERGY Renewable Energy Certificates will be offered to residential and commercial customers in the following enrollment levels:</p> <p>Residential: Small Home (500 kWh per Month); Medium Home (1,000 kWh per Month); and Large Home (1,500 kWh per Month).</p> <p>Commercial: Small Business (500 kWh per Month); Medium Business (1,500 kWh per Month); and Large Home (2,500 kWh per Month).</p>
Will my rates change over time?	<p>The rates paid for COLLECTIVE ENERGY Renewable Energy Certificates will be fixed for the initial 12 month term. At the time of renewal, the rate may change based on market conditions. In the event of a price or Product Mix change, all customers will be notified and offered the option to change products or discontinue participation in the program.</p>
What sources will be used in my certified product?	<p>COLLECTIVE ENERGY Renewable Energy Certificate is composed of 100% wind Renewable Energy Certificates sourced nationally. If I want to terminate this agreement/ contract, what is the early termination fee?	<p>The contract period is a minimum of 12 months. There is not an early termination fee.</p>
What length of agreement/ contract is required?	<p>The contract period is a minimum of 12 months and will be automatically renewed annually for an additional 12 month term, unless the customer provides notice of cancellation at least 60 days prior to the end of the current 12 month term of their contract.</p>
What other fees might I be charged?	<p>A billing service fee may apply (depending on the billing fees charged by the applicable utility for consolidated utility billing.). A late charge of 3% for bills that are unpaid for more than 24 days may be applied.</p>
